Rustin M. Moore, DVM, the Ruth Stanton Chair in Veterinary Medicine, officially became the 11th dean of the College of Veterinary Medicine in September 2015. A two-time graduate of the college, Moore has served Ohio State as chair of the Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences, executive director of the Veterinary Medical Center, associate dean for Clinical and Outreach Programs, and associate executive dean.

Moore has taught at all levels of the undergraduate, professional, and graduate curricula, both at Ohio State and at Louisiana State University, where he served on the LSU faculty from 1994 to 2006.

A native of Spencer, WV, Moore earned his Bachelor's Degree from the West Virginia University and his DVM and a Ph.D. from The Ohio State University. In addition, he is a diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Surgeons.

Bernadette Mazurek Melnyk serves as Vice President for Health Promotion, University Chief Wellness Officer, and Professor and Dean of the College of Nursing at The Ohio State University. She also is a professor of pediatrics and psychiatry at Ohio State's College of Medicine.

Melnyk's groundbreaking work spans evidence-based practice, intervention research, child and adolescent mental health, and health and wellness.

Since arriving at Ohio State in 2011, Melnyk has overseen significant steps toward establishing the nursing program there among the nation's elite. In 2015, Ohio State's master's program in nursing was named among the nation's top 25 by U.S. News and World Report.

She earned her Bachelor's Degree in Nursing from West Virginia University, her Master's Degree with a specialization in nursing care of children and pediatric nurse practitioner from the University of Pittsburgh, and her Ph.D. in clinical research from the University of Rochester, where she also completed her post-master's certificate as a psychiatric mental health nurse practitioner.

Thursday, September 16, 2021 - 5-7 p.m.

Settled along the west bank of the Scioto River near the intersection of Dublin and Trabue Roads is Quarry Trails, Central Ohio's newest Metro Park. This 180-acre park was created by a partnership between Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks and local real estate developer Thrive Companies.

Quarry Trails will have a dog park, climbing walls, single-track mountain bike trails, hiking trails, an observation deck, and connecting, on-site quarry lakes for kayaks and paddleboards. It will also provide access to the nearby Scioto River, and a walking path that leads to a stunning waterfall. Thrive Companies is also building a new housing development on the site, with access to all the natural benefits of the park.

CMC will be hosted by Columbus and Franklin County Metroparks team members, as well as, Thrive Companies, for tours of the park before it opens to the public!
