Democratic Candidate, Ohio Governor's Race

¥ NANWHALEY

Nan Whaley served as the mayor of Dayton from 2014 to 2022. A member of the Democratic Party, she was first elected to the mayorship in November

2013, after she served on the city commission for two terms. During her time in office, she founded the Dayton Region Manufacturing Task Force, declared a citywide state of emergency and developed a needle exchange program to help deal with the city's opioid crisis, and focused on revitalizing Dayton's struggling downtown. She is perhaps most noted for her handling of a 2019 mass shooting in the city's Historic Oregon District that claimed ten lives and left twenty-seven injured.

Prior to becoming mayor, Whaley was first elected to the Dayton City Commission in 2005, one of the youngest women ever chosen for a commission seat. She served on the Montgomery County Board of Elections and as a deputy to Montgomery County Auditor Karl Keith.

Additionally, Whaley presided over the United States Conference of Mayors from 2021 to 2022, and was a four-time delegate to the Democratic National Convention.

Whaley announced her bid for governor in early 2021, having previously run in 2018 before dropping out of the race and endorsing Rob Cordray. Whaley won the Democratic primary election and became the Democratic nominee for Ohio Governor in May. This made her the first woman to win a major party nomination to run for governor of Ohio and, because she was running with Cheryl Stephens, part of the first all-female ticket nominated by a major party for governor and lieutenant governor in that state

Whaley received her Bachelor's Degree in Chemistry from the University of Dayton, and a Master's Degree in Public Administration in Urban Studies from Wright State University.

An invitation was also extended to Governor Mike DeWine but his campaign declined to respond.
