He also worked closely with the Ohio Innocence Project to use DNA evidence to exonerate wrongly convicted individuals and free them from prison. His experience as a prosecutor led him to spearhead the creation of a Drug Court in Franklin County in 2009.

O'Brien received his undergraduate degree from Ohio Dominican University and his Juris Doctorate from The Ohio State University College of Law.




