During his time as a federal prosecutor with the Department of Justice, DeVillers prosecuted a variety of offenses involving the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act, the Continuing Criminal Enterprise statute, money laundering, corruption, wire fraud, murder, international drug trafficking, and terrorism. He tried 24 jury trials while an Assistant U.S. Attorney. He also led numerous task forces in conjunction with the FBI, ATF, DEA, IRS, and local police to combat white collar crime, terrorism, transnational crime, and corruption.

As part of the DOJ, DeVillers spent a great deal of time overseas, specifically in Albania, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Georgia, Irag, Kyrgyzstan, and Ukraine, where he worked to combat crime and corruption.

DeVillers began his career as director of the organized crime/gang unit for the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office in Columbus, where he was lead prosecutor in approximately 60 jury trials.

DeVillers received his Bachelor's Degree from the State University of New York at Oswego and his Juris Doctor from Capital University Law School.
