Retired Chief Justice, The Supreme Court of Ohio

Maureen O'Connor was the tenth Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, the first woman to lead the

state judicial branch of government, and the longest-serving statewi elected woman in Ohio history.

O'Connor joined the Court in January 2003, was re-elected as associa iustice in 2008 and elected twice as Chief Justice in 2010 and 2016.

Since 2015. O'Connor has endowed Ohio local courts with more the \$35 million to add and enhance technology. This funding has increas access to justice for litigants, defendants, and the public. 
