Patrick Losinski CEO, Columbus Metropolitan Library

Since 2002, Patrick Losinski has served as Chief Executive Officer of the Columbus Metropolitan Library. CML has 23 locations and an operations center with 880

employees and an annual operating budget of \$80M. Most recently, Losinski is helping lead a \$300M capital improvement plan for 20 new or remodeled library buildings.

CML received the Institute for Museum and Library Services National Medal in 2011 and was named Library Journal's National Library of the Year in 2010. Losinski is the past chair of the Urban Libraries Council's Governing Board and a former Governing Board member of the International Federation of Library Associations headquartered in The Hague.

Prior to joining CML, Losinski worked for public library systems in Colorado, Wisconsin, Illinois, and Ohio.

Losinski has a Master's Degree from the University of Wisconsin - Madison.


